Please fill out and return the enclosed staff application ASAP to begin the process. In the past we have accepted applications up to the date of Staff Training, which is June 10-16, 2023 (Saturday-Friday) provided there still remains an open position **(Please note the new date change as arrival is on Saturday afternoon instead of Sunday)**. Available summer staff positions after spring break have not been the case in some years. So... get your application materials submitted promptly. We are expecting an abundance of excellent ministry applicants for Camp Shipshewana 2023!

We are searching for Jr Counselors age 16 yo and older. A Jr Counselor will assist a Sr Counselor or Activity Director in supervising a group of campers during the session. We typically seek 3-6 Jr Counselors to serve as volunteers during each camp session. A Jr Counselor may serve more than one camp session but not two sessions consecutively or following a session they attended as a camper. The fatigue can inhibit your effectiveness. A Jr Counselor is awarded a \$150.00 Honorarium towards a future Camp Shipshewana session or retreat.

I encourage you to return your application & references by **ASAP** to allow time to complete the application process. Enclosed are **three reference forms**. Please give these reference forms, along with a stamped Brethren Retreat-addressed envelope, to adults who know you well, and with whom you have had regular contact in a character developing role (*i.e. a teacher/professor, coach/supervisor, youth/campus pastor, non-relative adult who has known you 3+ years, etc.*). **One reference form MUST be from your current Pastor/Youth Leader**. Please ask them to complete and return the reference forms to the Brethren Retreat within the week that you present the reference to them. I look forward to receiving your application. I pray that you are thankful for a kingdom that is unshaken and seek to worship God with reverence and awe this summer at Camp Shipshewana. It's our 103rd year of ministry!
