RECORD SETTING YEARS!

Ohhhh it feels good!! In 2024 we experienced a resurgence by many guest ministry groups. We broke the 2010 record for program income.

We were hopeful that 2025 would be a good year too. But it started slowly then became a great concern as retreats were canceled and camper registrations were very low. Then . . . a resurgence of guest group inquiries filled up July August, September and October. We are now on track to have back-2-back record setting years. This has never happened before!

Also . . . Lilly Endowment has issued a three-phase grant program for Indiana residential youth camps. We have been awarded \$150,000 for Phase #1. We are now working on a grant proposal for Phase #2 in the amount of \$750,000.

On the frustrating side . . . Living expenses continue to increase in many sectors of life for camper families. We desire more campers to attend our programs. We need to replenish our Scholarship fund with \$12,500 for 2026 Camp Shipshewana requests.

We too experience operating budget stress in the areas of food, utilities, insurance, & staff payroll. We are fervently stewarding our funds.
